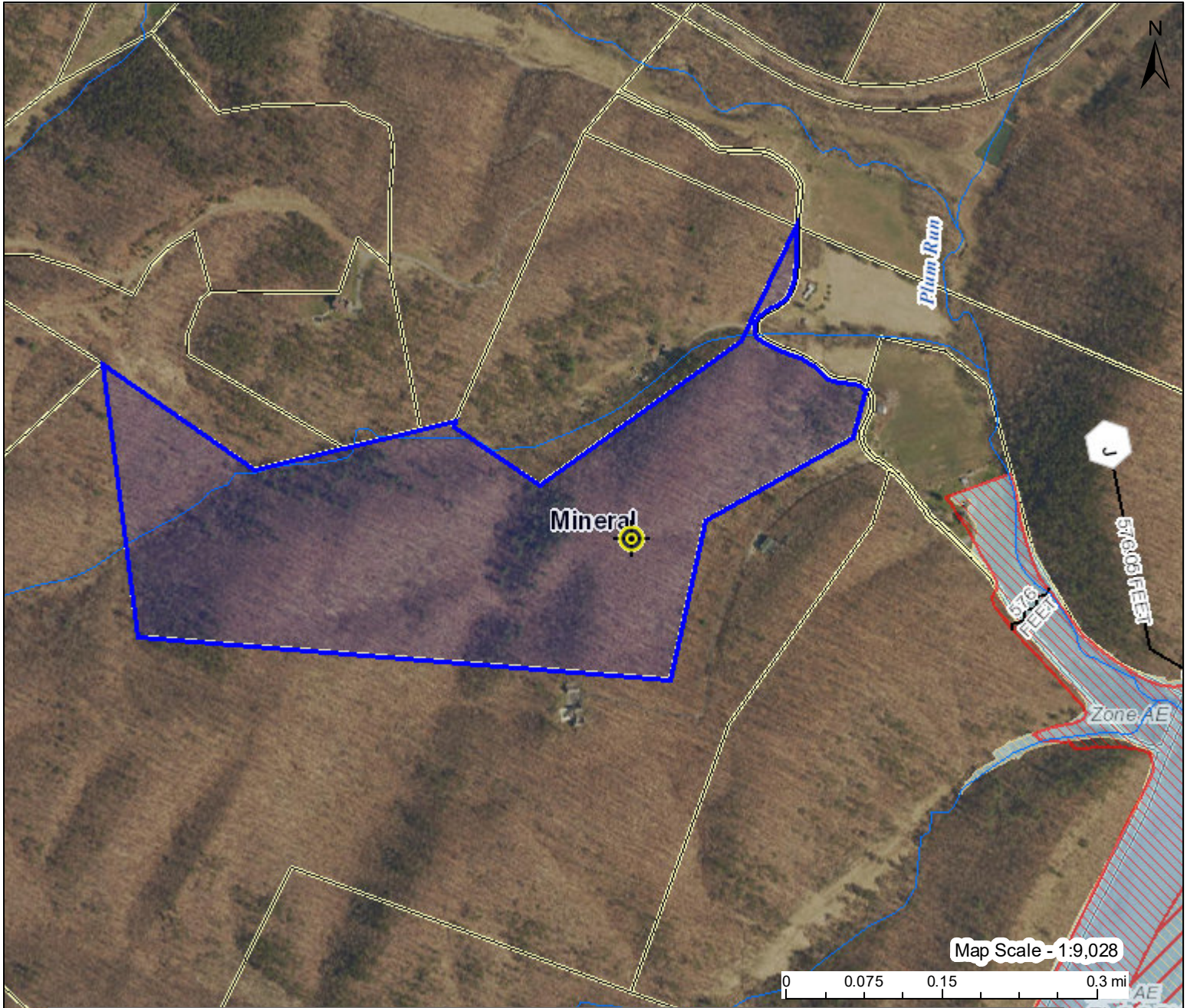


WV Flood Map
