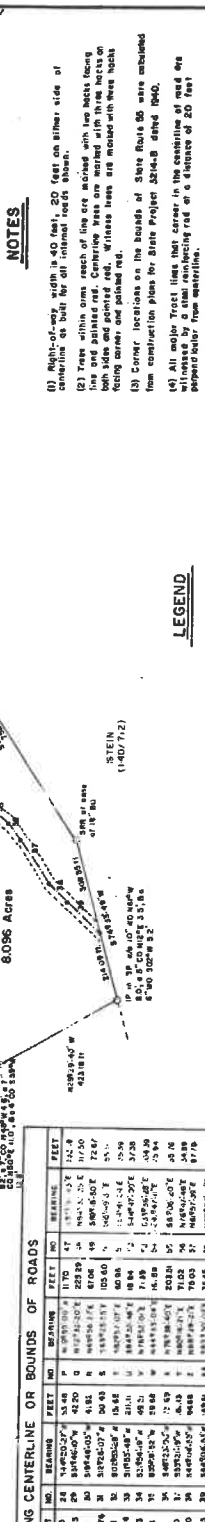

NOTES

1) Right-of-way width is 40 feet, 20 feet on either side of centerline as built for all internal road shows.

2) Tree within one reach of line are marked with top notch facing line and painted red. Cornering trees are marked in top notch facing corner and painted red. Witness trees are marked with three notch facing corner and painted red.

3) Corner locations on the bounds of State Route 55 are delineated from construction plans for State Project 32-54-5, dated 1940.

4) All major trees lying near corner in the centerline of road are marked with a steel ranging rod at a distance of 20 feet from proposed corner from masthead.
